



#### Theme & Subthemes

This interdisciplinary Conference will explore the cultural, historical, scientific and theoretical contexts of human-nature conflict. Environment is one of the central discourses of present era. Man's drifting away from an Eco-centric to an anthropocentric world, thereby distorting the green culture, has resulted in a global ecological crisis. Cultural and historical representation of nature and landscape has also a huge role to play in this moment of crisis. We cannot deny the scientific enquiry crucial for decoding the disequilibrium in biodiversity.

The conference would initiate a multi-layered academic discussion involving experts in physical sciences, social sciences and humanities. The Conference will provide a platform where wide spectrum of active and experienced researchers in domains ranging from material science to nuclear science - nano-science to particle physics - earth science to biological science, emerging environmental issues analogous to global warming. According to the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change, the Earth's mean temperature is predicted to rise by between 1.5-4.5 °C for a doubling of carbon dioxide in the atmosphere, which is expected by around 2050. To mention a few, in regard to climate research - CERN - an international organization of Nuclear and Particle Physics, where a project named "CLOUD" was undertaken to explore new dynamics of climatology. The new [CERN] findings point to cosmic rays and the sun-not human activities-as the dominant controller of climate on Earth. Nano-Science is also another allpervading domain very much relevant for eco-friendly development and technology. This conference would suggest ways in which a proenvironment culture of green initiatives, green alternatives, and green consciousness might be practiced. The conference would also address the complex problems of environmental sustainability and aid in structuring ethical issues crucial for saving the Green Culture. The conference would expect research papers from Humanities, Arts, Social Science and Science disciplines which would challenge the problematic of dualistic paradigm of viewing man and nature as separate.

The History Department of Government General Degree College, Tehatta, organized a one-day seminar on 'History and Historiography' on 22nd September 2022. Thirty-six students participated in the seminar, employing various research methodologies, including critical analysis, historiographical examination, and interdisciplinary approaches. Dr. Shibsankar Pal, the head of the institute, delivered the welcome speech with insightful thoughts. Mr. Raghunath Roy, Head of the Department of History, presented the theme address, perfectly describing the evolution of historiography in history writings on kings, war, and state, including diverse topics like polity and society. He emphasized the importance of objective history writing, citing Ranke's theory.

The core session began with Sunita Mondal, a third-semester student, speaking on the nature of history and its descriptions by scholars, utilizing a qualitative research approach. She concluded with E.H. Carr's observation that history is an unending dialogue between past and present. Rimpa Dey, another student, presented on the importance of history reading in the present day, highlighting its relevance to understanding heritage and ethnicity, employing a mixed-methods approach.

After the tea break, Mr. Gopal Mandal, assistant professor of history, spoke on the historiography of the imperial and Cambridge schools, critically analyzing primary sources. He addressed how imperialists and Cambridge historians distorted Indian history. Students Sourav Biswas, Maya Bairagya, and Rakesh Dhar presented on nationalist thoughts, Marxist analysis, and subaltern historiography, respectively, using various research methodologies. Mr. Pritin Dutta, assistant professor of political science, also addressed the topic. The convenor, Mr. Pallabi Chatterjee, summarized the addressed topics in his keynote speech, emphasizing the importance of interdisciplinary research. The seminar concluded with a vote of thanks delivered by Dr. Sibsankar Pal, OIC of Government General Degree College, Tehatta.
