

#### **Report**

The History Department of Government General Degree College, Tehatta, organized a one-day seminar on 'History and Historiography' on 22nd September 2022. Thirtysix students participated in the seminar, employing various research methodologies, including critical analysis, historiographical examination, and interdisciplinary approaches. Dr. Shibsankar Pal, the head of the institute, delivered the welcome speech with insightful thoughts. Mr. Raghunath Roy, Head of the Department of History, presented the theme address, perfectly describing the evolution of historiography in history writings on kings, war, and state, including diverse topics like polity and society. He emphasized the importance of objective history writing, citing Ranke's theory.

The core session began with Sunita Mondal, a third-semester student, speaking on the nature of history and its descriptions by scholars, utilizing a qualitative research approach.
